

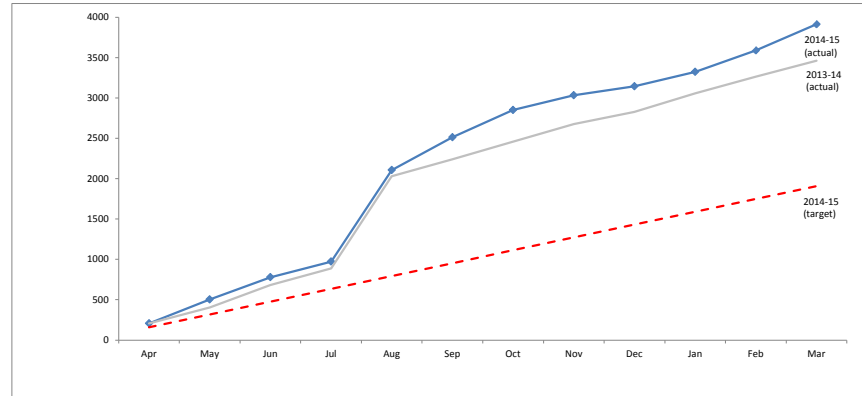

This breaks down to a monthly target of 159. However, recruitment is not linear and this should be viewed as a guide only.



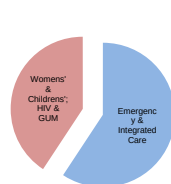
During 2014-15, the Trust has recruited 3916 participants into high quality clinical research studies.

Recruitment by year, broken down by division

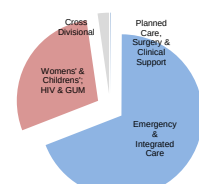
