OVERVIEW

This is a national course recognised by the Royal college of Anaesthetists and the Association of paediatric Anaesthetists. It is a one-day course that provides candidates with the opportunity to practice their hands-on management of an acute paediatric anaesthetic emergency utilising a high-fidelity patient simulator. Each scenario is followed by an interactive discussion of current paediatric guidelines and evidence-based recommendations as well as human factors and crisis resource management principles.

OBJECTIVES

Participants will practice the management of common anaesthetic emergencies in paediatric patients, along with reviewing the behavioural skills integral to successful crisis resolution.
