



PAEDIATRIC ANAESTHESIA

OVERVIEW

This one-day course provides the opportunity to refresh and refine clinical skills in the management of paediatric anaesthetic scenarios. The course is based on hands-on management of a high-fidelity paediatric patient simulator having an acute evolving event, in real time. Each scenario is followed by a discussion about current paediatric guidelines and evidence-based recommendations.

OBJECTIVES

Participants will practice the management of common and uncommon anaesthetic emergencies in paediatric patients, along with the generic behavioural skills integral to successful crisis resolution in a multi-disciplinary team setting.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- Specialist Registrars (Anaesthesia), especially Year 3, 4, 5
- Specialist Trainees ST 5, 6, 7 (Anaesthesia)
- Consultant and Non-Consultant Career Grades with occasional paediatric practice

The course is designed particularly with the occasional paediatric anaesthetic practitioner in mind, although others are welcome to apply.
