



ANAESTHESIA CRISIS RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

AIMS

This one-day course aims to train anaesthetists to avoid and deal with crisis situations. The main focus is on teamwork and behavioural issues. Useful practical points will also be covered. The setting is a simulated theatre using an advanced simulation manikin with realistic physical and physiological signs.

OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course participants will have a greater awareness of the importance of effective communication, teamwork, situation awareness and systems issues with regards to crisis avoidance and resource management.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is for anaesthetists at trainee level and is particularly **recommended for ST 3** (SpR 1). The course is also offered to consultant anaesthetists with the content tailored to meet their needs.
