





CONSCIOUS SEDATION

OVERVIEW

This intensive one-day course is aimed at doctors, nurses and ODPs involved in the care of patients undergoing potentially painful, uncomfortable and frightening procedures. It focuses on both understanding sedation techniques and improving non-technical skills like effective communication and leadership. The setting is a simulated theatre using an advanced simulation manikin with realistic physical and physiological signs.

OBJECTIVES

The course seeks to raise awareness of the potential 'pitfalls' in the peri-procedure care of these patients. By the end of the course participants will have a better understanding of sedation, patient safety, and how to recognise and deal with medical emergencies such as over-sedation, loss of airway, etc.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Doctors, nurses and ODPs involved in the care of patients undergoing procedures by sedation.
