



SIMULATION INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

AIMS

This multi-professional two-day course covers simulation training especially centred on human factors simulation and Acute Crew/Crisis Resource Management (ACRM). The course reinforces the principles of ACRM and covers the running of scenarios, the essentials of debriefing, and group dynamics. This is a well-established course, now in its seventh year, many of whose past delegates have successfully set up simulation centres around the country.

OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course, participants will have learned:

- The principles of ACRM and how to teach them
- How to run simulator scenarios and adapt them according to delegates' responses
- Practical aspects of using medium-to-high fidelity manikins for teaching
- How to run debriefing sessions
- How to deal with different group dynamics and maximise the effectiveness of teaching

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is suitable for senior clinicians from nurse to consultant grade with an interest in health care teaching and practical experience of acute medical care.
