

Summary of audit

We have completed the external audit of the Trust for the year ended 31 March 2020. This report includes information on our approach and opinion.

This presentation summarises the findings of our external audit of the Trust's financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2020. In line with the revised guidance, we did not complete testing on the Quality Report this year due to Covid-19.

Responsibilities of the external auditor

Financial statement audit

We issued an unmodified ("clean") opinion for the year ended 31 March 2020 financial statements, including the remuneration report.

In reaching our conclusions, we addressed the following significant risk areas:

- Recognition of NHS revenue and the associated provisions
- Property valuation
- Management override of controls

Use of resources

Reporting by exception if we are not satisfied the Trust has made proper arrangements for security economy, efficiency and effectiveness in the use of resources. We did not report any exceptions.

Annual Governance Statement

Reporting by exception if the Annual Governance Statement is incomplete or inconsistent with our understanding. We did not identify any issues requiring comment in our audit opinion.

We provided a detailed report on our audit of the Trust's financial statements to the Trust's Audit and Risk Committee and Board in June 2020. On 19 June 2020, we signed our audit opinion on the Trust's financial statements.

We have issued an unmodified audit opinion, with no reference to any matters in respect of the Trust's arrangements to secure economy, efficiency and effectiveness in the use of resources. The full opinion on the financial statements can be found in the Annual Report on page 108.




