Please find your query below with the corresponding responses included.

Yes parking fees apply to both Visitors and Patients.

- 3) Whether the car park is managed by the Trust or whether it has been contracted out.

Total income received for car park in 2012/13 was £900,500.

- 5) If the Trust charges for parking, please give details of increases in these charges over the past 10 years.

The Trust does not hold the information in the format you requested. The Trust can confirm there were two or three changes in the past ten years with no significant changes.
