



EUROPEAN PAEDIATRIC LIFE SUPPPORT (EPLS)

AIMS

A course providing training for multi-disciplinary healthcare professionals in the early recognition of the child in respiratory or circulatory failure and the development of the knowledge and core skills required for intervening, and preventing further deterioration towards respiratory or cardiorespiratory arrest. It also includes the management of the child or infant in cardiac arrest.

- Trauma management
