This two-day simulation course aims to train both doctors and nurses in the new field of acute oncology. The course focuses on the management of oncology emergencies and developing the practical skills required in acute oncology. - Manage oncology emergencies effectively, in keeping with best practice
- Work as a team to optimise patient care
- Develop practical skills including pleural drainage, paracentesis and management of central venous catheters
- Support acute oncology teaching at your own hospital
