56 Dean Street was opened on Tuesday 12 May 2009 by **Lord Darzi of Denham KBE**, Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Health.

On 4 July 2008, the Prime Minister and Health Secretary announced that Lord Darzi would lead a review of the NHS.

The review would advise on how to meet the challenges of delivering healthcare over the next decade.

Lord Darzi was knighted by the Queen, for his service to medicine and surgery in December 2002.







56 Dean Street is a state-of-the-art HIV and sexual health centre located in the heart of Soho.

Our full range of services are friendly, confidential and free.

We also offer free Wi-Fi wireless internet access and full disabled access.

- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
